INSTRUCTIONS FOR GRADUATES

1. Have something to eat before coming to school for commencement exercises.
2. Please remind friends and relative not to send gifts, flowers, etc. to school.
3. Early arrival of relatives and friends will insure better seats - doors will open at 7:00 p.m.
4. Clothing for boys: White shirts, straight dark ties, dark slacks, dark socks, and dark shoes. Jackets not necessary.
Clothing for girls: Dark heels. No earrings or bracelets. No part of dress should show under gown.
5. Sit up straight, well back on chair with both feet on ground. This applies particularly to those on front row and aisle seats. Look sharp--feel sharp--be sharp!
6. Do not applaud following invocation and benediction.
7. Do not applaud individual graduates.
8. Tassel will be moved from right to left side of cap on word from Dr. Tonini.
9. After recessional, please stay in columns, proceed as follows to turn in caps and gowns:

10. If your family wants your picture in cap and gown, have the picture taken at home prior to graduation. In order to preserve the beauty and dignity of the ceremony, we are asking that no pictures be taken during the exercises. Please explain this to your parents.
11. Please exercise the greatest of care with the tickets for your family. It is most embarrassing to deny entrance to your parents because their tickets may have been misplaced. No one will be granted entrance without a ticket.

- 7:15 p.m. Arrive at school, put on cap and gown in either girls (West line) or boys (East line) locker room. Do not wear cap and gown to school. Mirrors available in locker room. (Caps shall be worn perfectly straight.)
- 7:45 p.m. Final roll check of columns for start of processional.
- 7:55 p.m. Leave locker room.
- 8:00 p.m. Processional begins.
